START PLANNING EARLY

Great congregational retreats take time to plan! Begin by designating a retreat coordinator and planning team.

To schedule, contact The Mountain Group Sales office at least one year in advance. Weekend dates in the late Spring and Fall fill quickly, so schedule early. Weekdays and the winter months are times for negotiating great rates.

Once your date is scheduled, you will receive a contract to be signed and returned to confirm. Then you can send out a "save the date" notice to your congregation. Your event will be listed on our website for added online publicity and registration.
